Course prerequisite:	Three years of service as a licensed EMS provider at any level (MFR, EMT, EMT-S, EMT-P) with a Michigan life support agency or combination of life support agencies
Course dates:	August 24th - December 18thdidactic course contentJanuary 8th - March 12thstudent teaching (32 hours required)
Format:	Totally online, with the exception of three face-to-face sessions on December 13 th , 14 th , and 15 th at LCC's Lansing campus.
Student teaching:	May be completed either at the student's local EMS agency or within their local community under the supervision of a licensed Michigan I/C, or within EMS courses at LCC.
I/C licensure:	Upon successful course completion, student is qualified to take the Michigan Instructor/Coordinator licensure exam.
Course cost:	within LCC district:\$1483.00*outside of LCC district:\$2616.00**includes all tuition and fees; subject to slight increase as determined by action of the LCC Board of Trustees
