This hybrid course is designed for persons interested in becoming an EMS Instructor Coordinator.

In this 18-week course, students will learn public speaking skills, demonstrative skills, teaching methods, and current practices in the education of adult learners according to current EMS industry standards. Upon successful completion of this course in addition to 30 hours of student teaching, students will be eligible for the state licensing exam.

- Must submit letter from candidate detailing their background in EMS and intentions as an EMS I/C
- Must provide proof of 3 years fieldwork experience at current level of licensure for licensed Michigan EMS agency
- Must submit two (2) letters of professional recommendation; at least one (1) must be from a licensed EMS I/C supporting your teaching abilities
