

EMS Instructor Coordinator Course

Great Lakes EMS Academy will be conducting a hybrid EMS IC course starting in **January 2018**. This course will involve 94 hours of class time and the students will spend about 50 hours online completing some assignment and researching topics. The online component will include watching videos, doing some research, participating in discussion forums, and completing some “quizzes.” The purpose of this course is to prepare experienced EMS providers to become an instructor for EMS programs. Jerry Morton, MA, EMS IC, NRP will be the lead instructor.

Important Dates and \$

Classes are taught on Wednesdays and Thursdays (9 - 5 pm). We will have class and then take two weeks off to prepare for the next class.



Orientation will be **January 4th, 2018**. First week of class will be **January 24th and 25th**. Second week of class will be **February 14th and 15th**. Third week of class will be **March 7th and 8th**. Fourth week of class will be **March 21st and 22nd**. Fifth week of class will be **April 18th and 19th**. Sixth week of class will be **May 9th and 10th**.

At that time the students will complete 32 hours of student teaching time. That will need to be completed by **August 16th, 2018**. On that date we will meet for one last time. **The cost of the course will be \$1,160.00 + \$90.00 for the textbook on Amazon.**
